8-11 May, 2023

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Khangal Lake Pilot EEC Youth Camp and Pilot Eco-Education Trail

The Khangal Lake EEC Youth Camp was conducted on 8-11 May, 2023. The trail concept (2022) with explanations of the trail stations is available as a separate document. The detailed program and a photo documentation can be referred to below.

Objective

The Pilot Outdoor EEC Camp was to test the EEC info & exploration trail at Khangal Lake Natural Monument, introduce an ecosystem focus into EEC curricula in Mongolia (innovation), start cooperation with a local school from nearest soum (Umundelger), and provide on-the-job training for KKSPA rangers and Info-Center staff.

Results

- Practice test for the Khangal Environmental Exploration Trail
- Exploration of different perspectives on ecosystems and discovery of their interconnectedness (Meadow& Insects, Forest-Animals, Rock Formations and Geology, Forest Fire and Succession; Water, Khangal Lake Ecosystem / Birdlife, Human Interventions and Impacts)
- Practical nature exploration using several discovery tools (notebook, magnifying glass, binoculars, wildlife cameras, drones)
- Use of SPACES media and materials (videos, flyers, radio drama series)
- Video screening of nature documentaries
- Introduction of GIZ Baigali Biodiversity App
- On-the-job training of Info-Center staff of KKSPA
- Use of the Training Manual prepared by Sunjiidmaa Renchin
- On-the-job training for KKSPA rangers in EEC communication
- Involvement of local community leadership (head of 'Bak')
- Evaluation by the KKSPA team: excellent learning on the job for info-centre staff and rangers who feel more empowered and competent for their job now
- Evaluation forms filled out by participants: average ranking by youth was 9.8 / 10
- Video-documentation of the event
- Extensive sharing in social media through participants and trainers
- Creation of enthusiasm and motivation for future activities

Recommendations / Way forward after the Pilot project (KKSPA)

- Ongoing work on info-boards to be completed, produced and installed
- Manual for Trainers to be revised with a focus on an ecosystem approach
- Video production on the pilot camp to be completed
- Analysis of student evaluation forms to be completed
- Support Info-Center staff to implement similar camps / outdoor workshops
- Identification of partner schools from all soums / PA buffer zones
- Programming of further Youth / School Camps at Khangal Lake and initial financing requirement through projects before a self-financing modality with involvement of soums, Ministry of Education, corporate social responsibility or other parties can be found

- Options for cost reductions such as self-catering; participant's contributions, solidarity fund, etc. should be explored
- Combination of further Youth / School Camps with an action-orientation for youth, e.g. lake shore or watershed protection, wildlife monitoring using camera traps, involvement in local awareness raising activities using community theatre, EEC media 6 materials, etc.
