How about hiking?

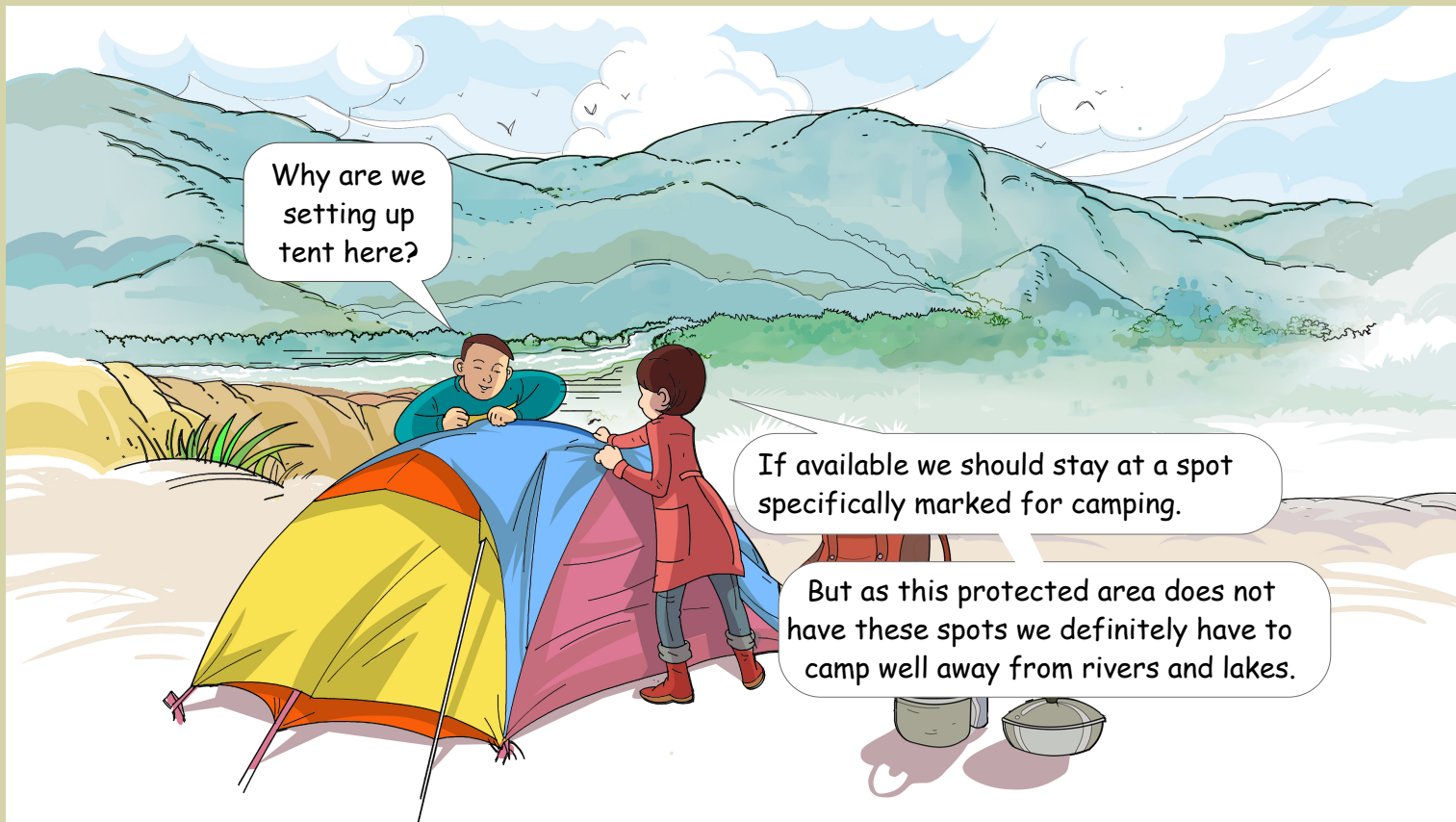
Well, that's okay but while hiking or riding we should not damage soil or plants or disturb animals. And of course our car should stay on the trails.

If available we should stay at a spot specifically marked for camping.

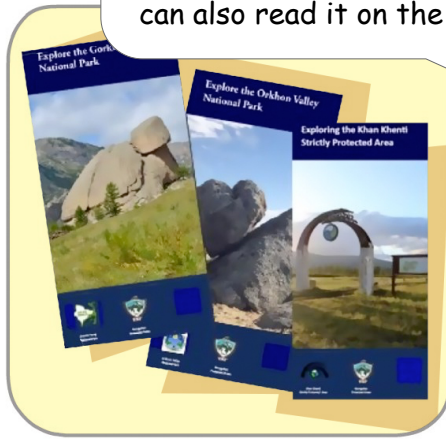
But as this protected area does not have these spots we definitely have to camp well away from rivers and lakes.



By camping and using a toilet or burying our excrements at least 50-60 meters away from water sources, we keep the water clean and safe.
