PHOTO REPORT of

Training Workshop Community Theatre for Environmental Education and Communication



At Freshwater Center, Mongolia June 6-8, 2023 The "Community theatre training" has successfully conducted by My Green Mongolian (MGM) campaign partners at the Freshwater Center (FWC) on 6-8 June, 2023. A total of 18 members of MGM from Freshwater center, ZSL, PCC, Khustai National Park and Ashid Anand Co.LtD. The training workshop was facilitated by Narangerel Yansanjav, PCC, Lkhagvaa, an actor, and by Bilegsaikhan, a producer. Both were also involved in the radio drama series and animated video on Wildfire that were used as a starting point for the theatre plot. The training was initiated by FWC, implemented as part of the MGM campaign and financed by the GIZ SPACES project.

DAY ONE (June 6)

After the official opening by Mrs. Budeekhuu, the director of FWC, the facilitators started the workshop with three most important starting questions: WHO, WHAT and HOW.

WHO – Interactive introduction: 1. How many years worked in Environment sector, 2. Whether they participated in any act playing from the childhood till now? 3. If they had dream to be an actor or writer?

WHAT -Learning Objectives and Agenda

By the end of this workshop, participants will have

- Learned about how community theatre acan contribute to enhance EEC in the field
- Learned to develop script writing and character development for community theatre performance
- learned necessary acting acting techniques
- practiced on preparation and performance of community theatre





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HOW - 3H and KAP

After showing the radio drama episode 1 and the Wildfire video, participants divided into 2 WGs. Their **Task**: What are the key environmental issues we are facing in Mongolia? What are the target groups to reach out to for each issue, and what are the most suitable media tools to reach them?

After the presentations of the WGs, the participants brainstormed on how they could turn the radio drama episode into a theatre play.


On the 2nd half of Day-1 the participants learned the acting techniques and breathing exercises necessary for a theatre play. The session was facilitated by actors, who were also involved in the radio drama.





The last exercise was "Spaghetti Tower"- Team Building

Throughout the 3 days of the training the participants measured their mood at the end of the last session.



DAY TWO (June 7)

DAY 2 started with the FC reflection.

As scheduled, Bilgee and Lkhagvaa (the actor) shared general principles, tips and ideas how to write a script.



Soon after this the participants divided into 2 WGS. **The task:** review, revise, add and finalize the pre-prepared script based on the knowledge they got in the morning.

After tea and coffee break, when the WGs had developed their scripts, the participants did a "killing the baby" exercise by combining two scripts into one under Bilgee's facilitation.

After lunch the participants developed character profiles and practiced script reading to select the roles for the performance. After more than 10 rounds of reading aloud the scripts of each role, the actors selected the roles among participants.



The 2nd day workshop finished with the voice rehearsal and chose the Feedback Committee (FC) members for the next morning.

DAY THREE (June 8)

DAY 3 started with hearing FC members on what happened on day 2, how did they feel and what they learned. The participant from Arkhangai province, Mr. Altangerel, the ranger, shared: "This is my very first experience at a training where I have learned a lot and same time had so much fun".

The whole morning the participants did dress rehearsals under direct supervision of the actors. The rehearsal began with body and mouth warming exercises.








The audience enjoyed the play and expressed their big appreciation, congratulations, and gratitude to the performers.
